Chetola Resort Hosts the 7th Annual Corkscrew & Brew 5K: A Scenic Run for a Charitable Cause

Chetola Resort, along with SAVOR Blowing Rock and local breweries, host a unique 5K experience allowing participants to drink and dash for the local community.

BLOWING ROCK NC, April 16, 2019 – The 7th Annual Corkscrew & Brew 5K will be held Saturday, May 4 on the grounds of scenic Chetola Resort. Wine lovers and craft beer enthusiasts alike will have the chance to run an invigorating 3.1-mile course to support Aiden Amason of Boone, NC.

In accordance with SAVOR Blowing Rock: A Celebration of Food & Drink, the race will include four “hydrating” stations featuring a variety of Timberlake’s wine and AMB craft beer (must be 21 or older). Appalachian Mountain Brewery proudly partners with the event to include their award winning brews as refreshment while running. The race includes an alcohol free division open to any age group. Not a runner? Enjoy a to-go breakfast on the Timberlake’s Restaurant patio complete with a Bloody Mary and Mimosa bar.

Founded in philanthropy, the Corkscrew & Brew 5K has successfully distributed more than \$12,000 to local organizations and families in need. This year’s race participants will run as Aiden’s Army in support of Aiden Amason, a Boone native diagnosed at age 6 with Demoplastic Small Round Blue Cell Tumors-stage 4. Aiden, of Hardin Park School is now 9 years old and has completed multiple rounds of chemotherapy and radiation. Aiden is being treated at Brenner Children’s Hospital in Winston-Salem, NC, and has previously been treated at Sloan Kettering Memorial Hospital in New York City.

“We are so thankful for all of the wonderful doctors and nurses!” says his mom, Sharron. “We are still on our journey, but thankful for everyone who is walking this journey with us. Aiden is currently receiving additional chemo for the next nine months. We know awesome things are in store for Aiden!”
